DUNCAN QUINN

British-born New York-based designer Duncan Quinn clearly takes his style cues from the natty English gents of Jermyn Street and Savile Row. He uses a two-piece split yoke (the shaped section at the shoulders that connects all other parts of the shirt), which imitates the natural slope of a man's back. \$250 to \$295, duncanquinn.com

HAMILTON

This fourth-generation family clothing company was founded in 1883, and today it's the premier custom shirtmaker for Barneys New York. Made-to-order shirts can be bought online in your choice of collar, cuff, and pocket styles, and in one of 500 fabrics. \$230 to \$380, hamiltonshirts.com

RUFUS

This is a modern American dress shirt with a slim fit. The shirts feature hidden splashes of color (courtesy of the contrasting fabric found inside the cuffs), strategically placed darts down the back for a more tailored fit, and red stitching on the cuff buttonholes. Signature cuff links are provided with each French-cuff shirt. \$175 to \$195, rufushirts.com

ZACHARY PRELL

Prell's shirts are crafted with today's more casual office dress code in mind. The tail, which hits at midpocket, is the ideal length to be worn untucked. Mother-of-pearl buttons are evenly spaced and look sophisticated with or without a tie. \$165 to \$225, zacharyprell.com

SEIZE SUR VINGT

An American take on a French aesthetic. These dress shirts are made in New York City but inspired by the legendary Parisian shirtmaking house Charvet, known for its smaller collar and short, slim fit. Shirts are cut from the finest Egyptian cottons and hand-sewn in the hills of northern Italy. \$170 to \$400, 16sur20.com
